

# Senior Honors - CHECKLIST

**During the first week of the fall term in the senior year**, the student should submit a thesis prospectus (developed over the summer in consultation with the primary advisor) for approval. See website for guidelines. Once approved by the primary advisor, [one member **MUST** be a PNP (core) faculty member]. You will not be able to register for L64 PNP Honors until all approvals are received; upon which a section will be created in WUCRSL linking your primary advisor to a section. You will be informed of this section by the PNP administrator.

**Both Committee members MUST agree to be available to attend the Honors defense; which should be scheduled the week after Spring Break.** Later dates conflict with the College of Arts & Sciences required dates to have Latin Honors on line.

**Normally, one committee member MUST be a PNP (core) faculty member. If this is not your primary, the secondary member will be assigned by the Honors Coordinator.** An email sent to [pnp@artsci.wustl.edu](mailto:pnp@artsci.wustl.edu) from faculty members on committee is required. Emails will be attached.
